

Visiting Catavino - theLab: This welcoming wine shop, tasting room, and event space is tucked away on Porto's Rua do Bonjardim, attracting local artists and featuring natural, organic, and low-intervention wines. It's an exemplary representation of the sustainable business model Catavino strives for, involving and benefiting the local community. The Lab is where founders Ryan and Gabriella host dinners, exclusive experiences, and concerts, and sell natural, sustainable, low-intervention wines and other products.

Dining Experiences: Food and wine are the lifeblood of a Catavino trip, and no place is more fruitful for foodies than in Portugal. Travelers may take part in a traditional cooking session with the Viscountess or a class with a Michelin-star chef, or even harvest meaty oysters from the sea. Of course, plenty of eating is involved, from handmade cheese to farm-raised meats to traditional desserts.



The Azores: Within this stunning archipelago of hidden crater lakes, steaming hot springs, and gentle ocean swells, there are pineapple plantations,
