
featuring noble materials, iconic pieces, moldings, ceramics, and the interplay

Within the Palais Royal Restaurant just minutes from the Nolinski Paris, Chef Philip Chronopoulos has been awarded 2 stars by the Michelin Guide. Tucked away between the columns of the Palais Royal, the Palais Royal Restaurant blends seamlessly with its surroundings - under the soft glow of wall sconces, the restaurant combines modern furnishings with elegant table settings. At the hotel, this acclaimed Chef's influences are evident at Nolinski Le Restaurant, offering traditional, elegant French cuisine that honors the culinary classics of the past, in a decor that subtly combines the spirit of the seventies with Art Deco, in a nod to the 1930s hotel facade. The adjacent plush and intimate Grand Salon cocktail bar has live music from Wednesday to Saturday in this delightful setting.

Amenities include the MyBlend by Clarins, blending French elegance and Swiss Riviera treatments; a pool, sauna, and steam room; personal training sessions on-site or in the Louvre gardens; and complimentary in-room fitness classes by Kalon.

mind coaching sessions, and wellness drinks. Guests are invited to flood their


tissues with oxygen at La Capsule's hyperbaric oxygenation chamber or float in

Cour des Vosges – An Intimate Royal Hideaway

Tucked into the romantic Place des Vosges in the Maris district, Paris' oldest planned square, the Cour des Vosges is a boutique jewel for those who want to live like a Parisian amongst Parisians. Designers Lecoadic-Scotto have created a masterpiece within a former royal palace and the Hôtel de Montbrun, a listed historical monument.



The exclusive landmark site is recognizable by its pink brick facades and slate roofs, while inside each of the 12 rooms and suites opens onto views of the romantic Square Louis XIII and its splendid houses. Going further inside, all rooms offer a direct view of the charming and romantic Place des Vosges, while the suites boast 16-foot ceilings, a four-poster bed, a kitchenette, a couch, a selection of novels, and a complimentary minibar.



Whether breakfast, afternoon tea, or dinner at 19 Place des Vosges, one is treated to thoughtfully chosen menu items, from turkey and truffle croquemonsieur to beef bourguignon with bacon and button mushrooms. One mustn't miss the Brach-La Patisserie Corner, with traditional desserts, loaf cakes, and pastries, available to enjoy in a cozy setting or as a takeaway. The sybaritic indulgences continue with in-room spa treatments and at the

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












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
